Summary / Objective

Under general supervision from the Executive Director and Operations Supervisors, performs a variety of semi-skilled work in the direction and control of traffic, inspection of trash, litter control, and recovery of recyclable materials and Household Hazardous Waste (HHW).

Duties / Responsibilities

Traffic Control / Waste Disposal:

- Works as a team with co-workers to ensure operation of waste disposal runs in a smooth, efficient, and safe manner
- Effectively communicates (verbally) with all customers to ensure proper placement of vehicles for unloading at the tipping face and direction to unload recyclables, HHW, and other materials as applicable
- Ensures publicly-posted safety rules are followed by customers in tipping areas
- Checks tickets to ensure customer is in the proper disposal location and all extra fee items have been paid for (i.e. freon units, tires, extra mattresses)
- Communicates with scalehouse personnel to ensure operations are correctly processed (i.e. undeclared fee items)
- Performs random load checks and files corresponding paperwork
- Performs visual and verbal inspection/verification of all vehicles and waste to prevent the disposal of hazardous or unauthorized waste.
- Direct operations of the on-site recycling area and actively separates and salvages recyclable and HHW materials from disposal loads.
- In the absence of HHW Personnel, accepts Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) for temporary placement on HHW carts.
- Works closely with temporary labor with training needs and guidance on tasks, procedures and policies

Litter Control / Site Maintenance:

- Performs litter control on the landfill and roads coming to the facility
- Supervises / works with temporary labor crews for litter control
- May assist in facility and grounds maintenance / management tasks

Safety:

- Follows all written and non-written safety standards to ensure personal, co-worker, and customer safety
- Performs all job duties in a manner to ensure employee and customer safety
- Notifies Supervisor of potentially harmful or unsafe situations
- Wears appropriate PPE as directed

Other:

- Responsible for proper care and maintenance of vehicles assigned
- Assist in housekeeping of Trans-Jordan vehicle fleet
- Collects and disposes of waste, shovels snow, maintains outside sidewalk, and assists in keeping outside premises in an orderly condition
- Performs other job-related duties as assigned or duties in other job descriptions, as qualified

Minimum Qualifications

Education and Experience

- Preferred six (6) months of experience in a field closely related to these duties; OR
- An equivalent combination of closely related education and/or experience

- Perform duties in a safe manner
- Knowledge of landfill regulations and procedures
- Ability to direct traffic efficiently and safely

- Excellent customer service skills
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with management, employees and the public
- Make decisions based on brief visual observations
- Follow through on challenges as they arise
- Act independently when appropriate
- Learn and apply new training and information
- Record information accurately
- Use tools and equipment appropriate to completing job tasks (i.e. two-way radio)
- Perform manual labor

Working Conditions & Physical Requirements

- This position may include frequent lifting up to 25 lbs, occasional lifting up to 50 lbs and carry 25 lbs up to 100 feet.
- This position requires that the person stand continuously and sit or walk with bending, stooping, squatting, twisting, reaching, and working on irregular surfaces and uneven ground; a full range of motion in the shoulders, arms, hands, wrists, legs, and feet; and manual dexterity and hand-eye coordination; visual acuity as needed to inspect loads
- Must work in extreme outside weather conditions (i.e. hot and cold) with constant exposure to traffic hazards, noise, dust, fumes, grease and unsanitary conditions

Essential Functions

Essential functions of this position include the ability to effectively and safely perform the duties listed above, in the traffic
control / waste disposal and litter control / site maintenance areas, for a full shift (40 hours per week in 4, 10-hour shifts).
